## **CALL FOR ABSTRACTS**

Dear colleagues, let me invite you to participate at the 10th ANNUAL CONFERENCE ON ARCHITECTURE AND URBANISM 2021, which will be organized again on-line, this year on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2021 by the Faculty of Architecture of Brno University of Technology, Czech Republic.

The international conference will be organized for PhD students in order to exchange experience and knowledge between research institutes and young researchers during the meeting. The students will present the results of their research focused on the thematic scope of the conference in two areas of Architecture and Urban planning. This year's 10th annual conference is a follow up on previous conferences held in Prague in 2011, 2014 and 2017 in Bratislava in 2012 and 2015 and in Brno in 2013, 2016, 2019 and 2020.

Previous keynote speakers: 2019 – Professor Timothy Brown from Clemson University (former vice-dean of IIT Chicago). 2020 – Professor Christopher De Sousa of Ryerson University, Canada.

2021 keynote speaker will be announced

We are inviting you to present an oral presentation of 15–20 slides in English, a full-text of your paper 4–5 pages long also in English (when accepted in double-blind peer review, the paper will be published in the Book of Proceedings and indexed in Google Scholar as well as it will be sent to Clarivate for review). We also invite you to exhibit your conference poster (B1 size, portrait oriented) which will present the essence of the topic of your research at an accompanying exhibition in an on-line gallery similar to the 2020 conference.

We will be happy to review the full text of your original unpublished paper, after your abstract is recommended by the scientific committee.

Submitted Abstracts and Full-texts will be assessed by the Scientific Committee of the Conference. Information of acceptance of Abstract and Full-text will be delivered to each person individually by e-mail. Participation in the conference is free of charge.

Text of 7 200 - 9 000 characters including spaces (in MS Word format, editable),

For the formatting of the Full-text see Instructions for Authors,

Illustration in the range of max 1 full-page illustration - drawing, photograph, diagram,

Illustrations resolution 300 dpi width of 150 mm (jpeg),

Resource and Illustration citation in accordance with ISO 690 (author-date),

The author of the paper is responsible for ensuring the copyright and reproduction rights of illustrations included in the paper

#### **Exhibition poster:**

Poster size B1 (70 cm width, 100 cm height), submitted in .pdf format (resolution 300dpi, without password protection), the poster will include a label placed at the bottom edge in the horizontal strip of 5 cm height, according to the following example:

Selected posters will be presented at an accompanying on-line exhibition. Selected papers might be published in the Book of Proceedings. #### Form of presentation:

Oral presentations of approx. 20 (15–20) minutes accompanied by an image presentation (PowerPoint, pdf, jpeg, video) in English. Each thematic group presentation will be followed by a brief discussion. The organizer provides the ZOOM conference platform. Lecturers will have the opportunity to schedule a pre-recording date during October or send a video recording of their lecture to the organizer (instructions will be provided).

The conference organizer will make the conference platform available in advance, including instructions to the presenters. The organizer assumes that each presenter will give a separate presentation (either during prerecording, or by submitting of the vide-recording from their own computer equipped with a microphone and webcam, connected to the broadband Internet, at a speed of at least 1.5 Mbps (up / down) via ZOOM.
